

Alignment of the STREAMin³ Preschool STREAM Group Activities to the Virginia's Early Learning and Development Standards (ELDS) Focus Areas

STREAMin³ is a comprehensive curriculum model for children ages birth to five that focuses on and encourages children's development across multiple skills. This comprehensive and integrated approach promotes learning and growth across a wide range of developmental domains, as is evident in the crosswalk to the Virginia Early Learning and Development Standards (ELDS) at the Focus Area level.

STREAMin³ intentionally integrates interactions and active exploration into all activities and experiences. This focus on interactions, active exploration, and child-focused learning means that many standards and focus areas are intentionally integrated into all of the STREAM Group Activities. This crosswalk highlights the Focus Areas that are explicitly included in each activity. However, in many cases, additional focus areas can be integrated into learning based on the interactions and scaffolds an educator uses to meet the needs of every learner.
