

STREAMin³ On-Demand Learning (Canvas Connect)

How to register, enroll, and track your on-demand coursework

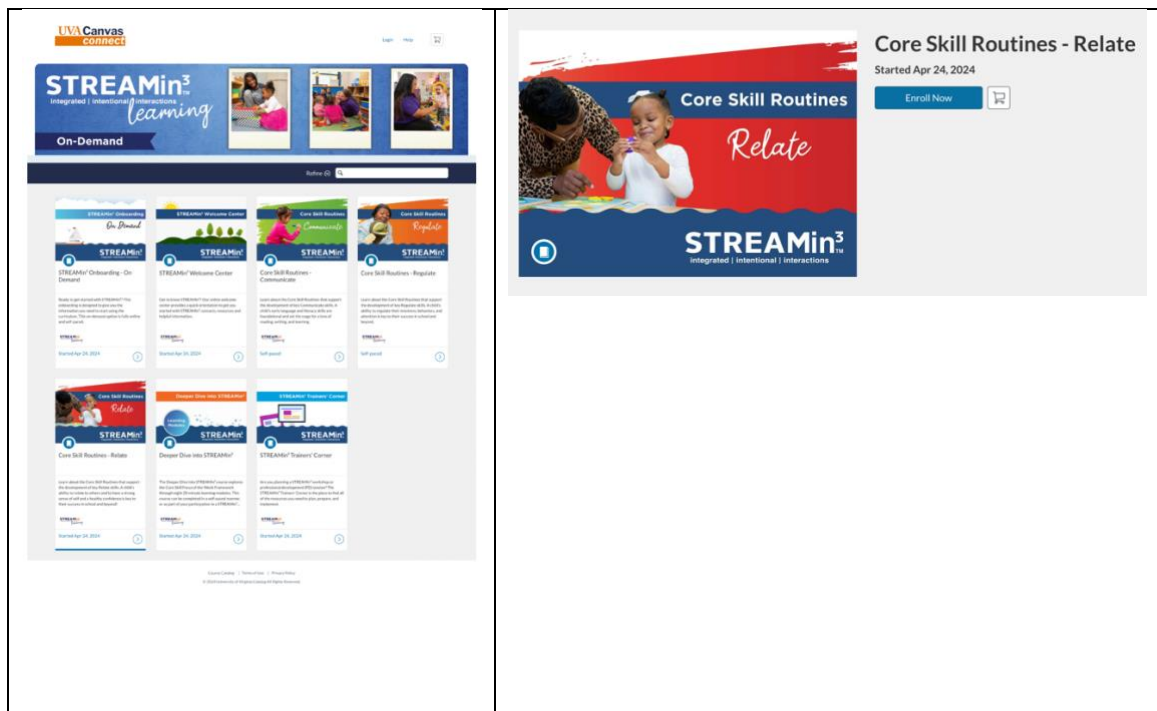
Steps outlined in this guide:

- How to register/set up an account on the STREAMin³ On-Demand Learning Center.
- How to enroll in your first course.
- How to set up and use multi-factor authentication.
- How to enroll in additional courses and track your on-demand learning.

How to register/set up your learning account and enroll in your 1st course:

Setting up your learning account and enrolling in your first STREAMin³ on-demand course typically happen together. The steps below walk you through this process.

1. Go to the STREAMin³ On-Demand Learning Center (UVA Canvas Connect via Catalog)

2. Select a course you would like to take.
3. Click “Enroll Now”



4. Before you can enroll, you'll need to **create your account**. Complete the following information.

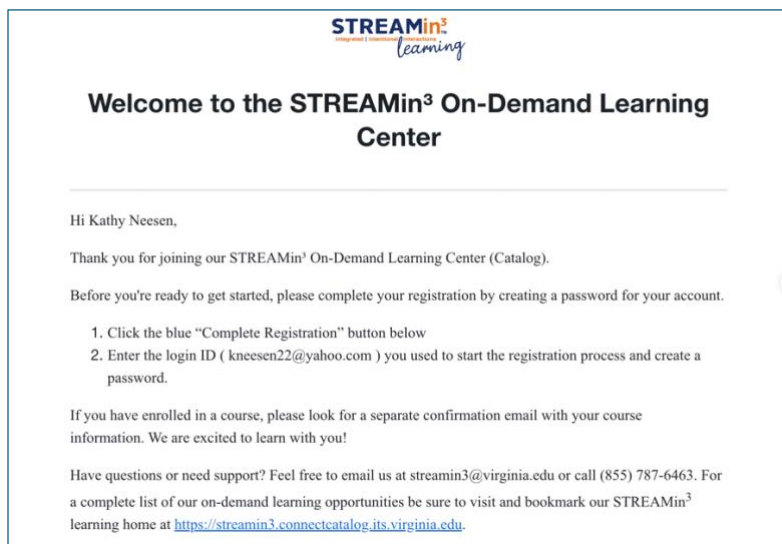

5. Once you click **Register New Account**, you will be asked to Enroll in the course you selected.

ATTENTION: Before doing this, it's helpful to complete your account registration first and set up your password. Check your inbox for an email with the following subject line:

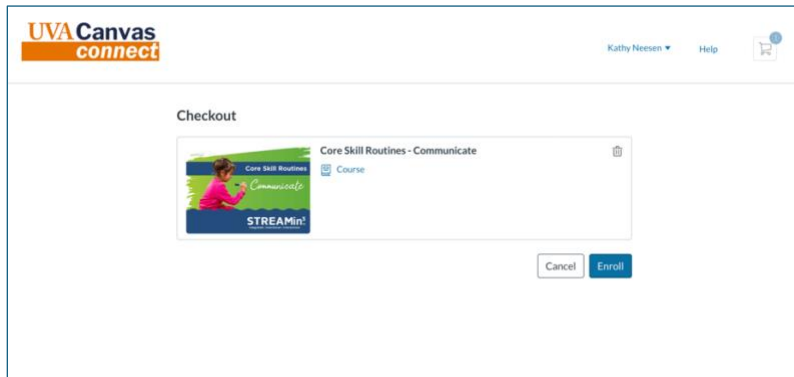

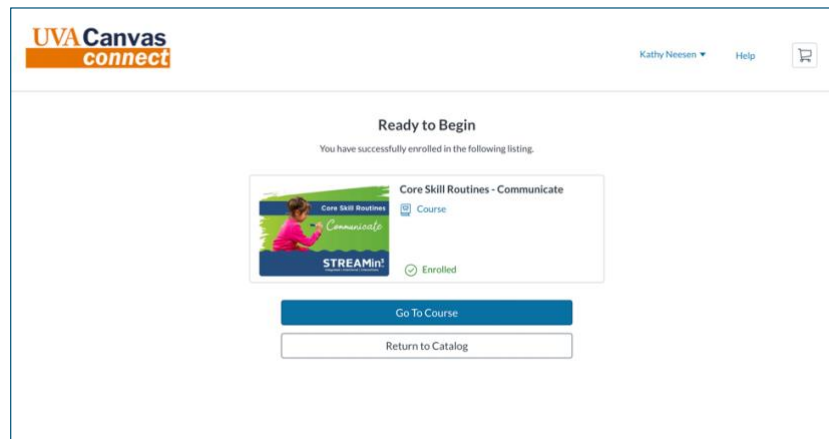
6. Click the **"Complete Registration"** button to set up your password and log into the STREAMin³ On-Demand Learning Center on Catalog.

7. Now you are ready to move forward and **“Enroll”** in the course you selected.

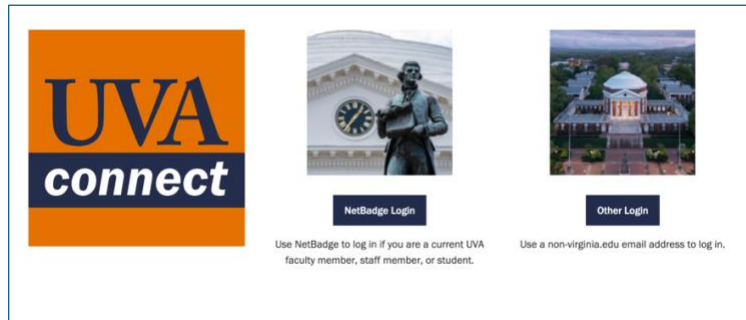
*Please note: Sometimes, you may be sent from the complete registration process to the STREAMin³ On-Demand Learning Center dashboard on Catalog. Your course listing will not show up yet in the “in progress” list. If this happens, check to see if the course listing is still open in another browser tab, or you can click on the **UVA Canvas Connect logo** to get back to our home page and find the course again.*



8. Click Go To Course. You will be directed to the Canvas Dashboard, where you can start your course experience.



9. Before reaching the dashboard, you may be directed to the Canvas Connect Login Page. If so, select “Other Login” and submit the email and password you just created.



10. During your first or second visit to our learning center, you may be asked to set up a Multi-Factor Authentication. This is a second security screening meant to protect you.
11. To set up Multi-Factor Authentication:
 - a. Submit your cell phone number
 - b. Select your carrier.
12. Click “Send.”
13. Enter the 6-digit Canvas verification code you receive via text. If you are using your own device, you may select “Remember this Computer.”


What if...

- ...your cell phone carrier not on the list?
- ...your number is an international number?

If the answer is yes to either question, you may experience issues with this method of multi-factor authentication. **Please reach out to us via the STREAMin³ hotline to set up an alternate option using an app called DUO.**

Multi-factor Authentication

You are required to set up multi-factor authentication.

Multi-factor authentication increases security by requiring that you have something in your physical possession, in addition to knowing your password, in order to log in to Canvas. This can be a device that can generate verification codes, or a phone that can receive text messages. MFA can be configured by scanning the QR code below using a Time-based one-time password (TOTP) authenticator app on iPhone or Android (ex: Google Authenticator, Microsoft Authenticator, Authy). Other tokens can be configured by entering the secret key **CIO5VJXDWJVRDCTQLCZU4ZMYOD74I2PP**. Once you have configured multi-factor authentication, it is recommended that you go to your profile page and print out a set of back-up codes, in case your normal multi-factor device is unavailable.

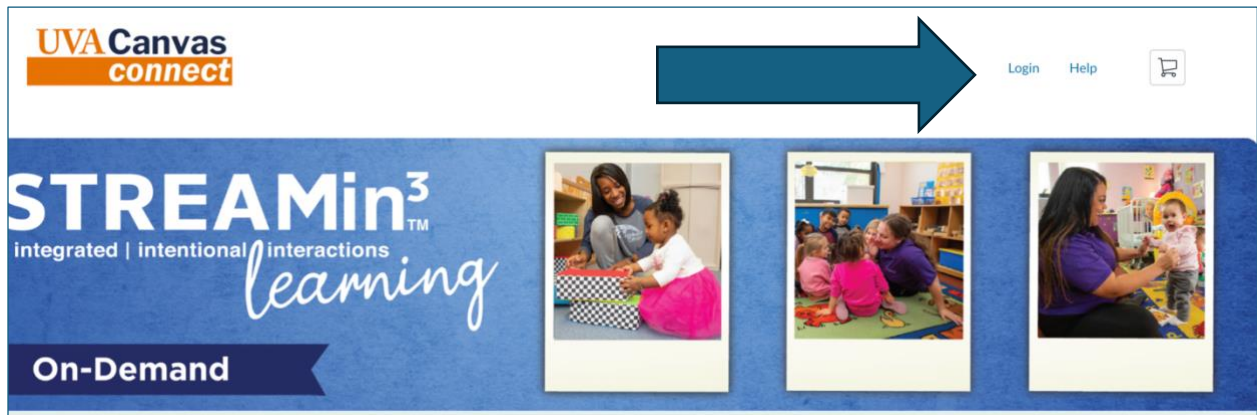

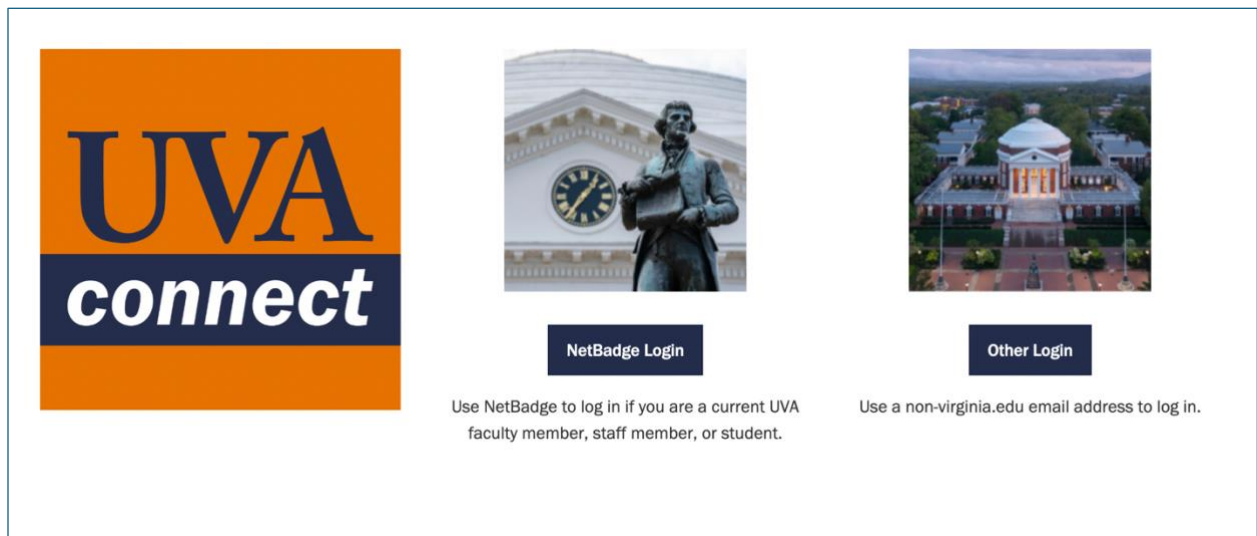


1. Visit: Go to the STREAMin³ On-Demand Learning Center (Catalog)

3. You will be directed to the Canvas Connect Login page first. Click on **Other Login**.




4. **Log in** with your email and the password you created during your initial account set-up. Forgot your password? You can click the **Forgot Password?** Link to reset your password.

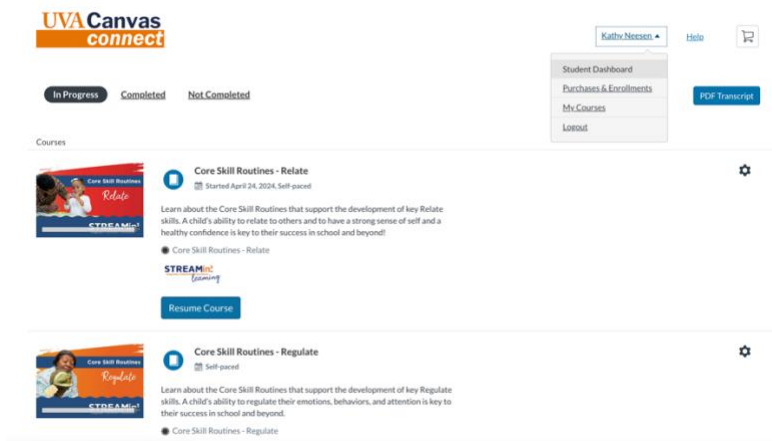
5. Complete the multi-factor authentication. If you are using the cell phone process, a verification code has been sent to you via text. Please enter it here and click **Verify**.
